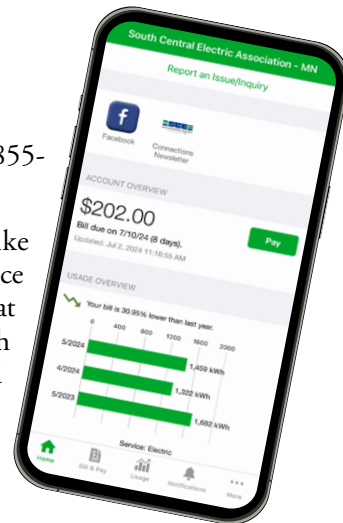

bills. You can set up auto-payments or log in and pay your bill monthly. You can pay with either your bank account or credit card. SmartHub is a great tool for members to access their accounts. You can sign up for SmartHub on the home page of our website (southcentralelectric.com) with the "Login To Your Account" link. Members can also download the SmartHub App through the Apple App Store or Google Play on their mobile devices.

We don't take credit cards at our office. You can make a payment with a credit card with our pay-by-phone option. It is easy to use. You will need your SCE bill and follow the automated prompts. The pay-by-phone

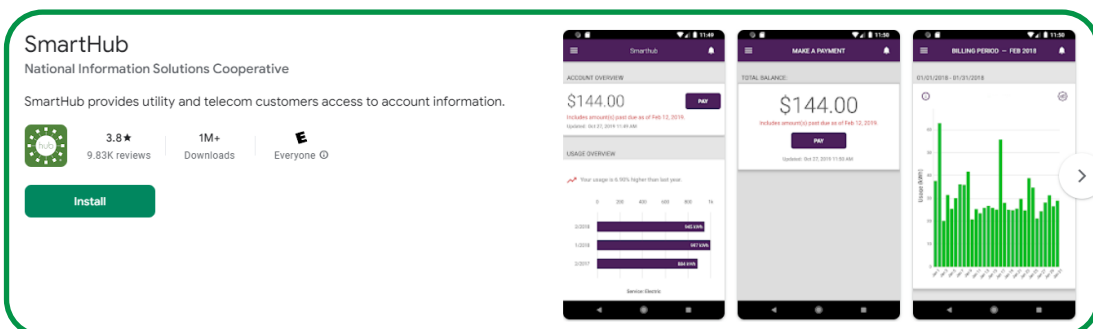
