Each contestant must submit an application, along with an essay and an interview.

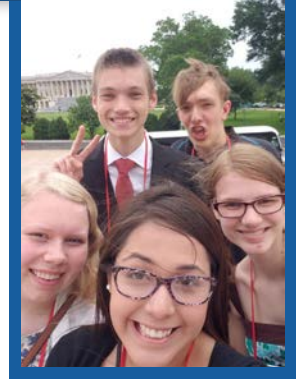
